Welcome home 82nd SFS deployed Airmen

Family, friends, spouses and coworkers anxiously awaited the return of the deployed 82nd Security Forces Squadron members to Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas, Aug. 1, 2016.

A crowd of people who waited impatiently to see their loved ones step off the bus – it had been roughly six months since they deployed to the desert and this was the opportunity to make up for lost time.

"The hardest part was the nights," said Andrea Fagnani, whose husband, Senior Airman Matthew Fagnani, returned from deployment. "But I always had support ... it was all the squadron. The people here are awesome. Major Nice (82nd SFS operations officer), the first sergeant's wife, our key spouse – who called me once a month – and even Major Wyatt (82nd SFS commander) called me and asked me how I was or if I needed anything."

"It was really helpful to know that when my wife had to move into a new house, I really didn't have to wonder if people from the squadron were going to be able to help," said Senior Airman Fagnani. "I just had to say, 'hey, tell someone from the squadron that you need help,' and I knew they would pitch in and she could rely on them."

Staff Sgt. Genevie Navarro, 361st Training Squadron military training leader, also reunited with her husband that day. Her and their two children could hardly wait to see their beloved husband and father, but the children were unaware of his arrival and were thrilled when he surprised them at school.

"I had butterflies," she said. "We're going to go spend some quality time together, just us two, and he's been spending some time with the kids during his R and R (rest and recuperation time) just to bond with them."

MISSILE ROAD GATE WORK

On Thursday, May 19, road construction to repair the intersection of Missile Road and Avenue D/E will move to the next phase. The contractor will place traffic control signs and barricades to close off the work area. The eastern most lane (southbound left lane) of Ave. D and western most lane (northbound left lane) of Ave. E will be closed and will remain closed approximately two weeks. Complete intersection repair will be accomplished in multiple phases, estimated completion late June 2016.

The Missile Road gate will continue to be closed to traffic, with the exception of commercial vehicle traffic. Drivers are asked to please respect the barricades and exercise caution while driving around the construction area. This project will be completed as quickly and as safely as possible, and we ask for your patience and cooperation during the construction period.
